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Director General's Message

feel very proud to mention that ESIC has completed 67 years of illustrious journey on 22nd February, 2019. Even though late, I congratulate all ESICians for their hard work and contribution during the last year to take ESIC to new heights.

I am happy to mention that in a historic decision taken by the Govt. of India, the monthly contribution in ESI Scheme by the employees has been reduced from 1.75 % to 0.75% and that of the employers from 4.75% to 3.25% presently benefitting 3.6 crore Insured Persons and 12.85 lakh employers. I am sure that this decision will attract more formal sector workers to ESI Scheme. I assure all that their will be no reduction in the benefit already being provided to the Insured Persons under ESI Scheme.

ESIC is moving ahead with various new initiatives. To empower the Insured Persons, ESIC has come up with some novel ideas and launched Health Passbook to maintain health records of IPs and their dependant family members. The process is also on to launch a 'Welcome Kit' for the newly Insured Persons to inform them about various benefits under the ESI Scheme. The Unified Website of ESIC has been launched with a repository of common information and uniformity in design and content, thereby making all Regional/ Sub-Regional Offices a part of this website.

In the 176th meeting of ESIC, it was decided to allow non Insured Persons to avail OPD and IPD medical services from underutilized ESIC Hospitals after levying subsidized user charges and also to enhance the wage exemption limit for payment of employees' share of contribution from ₹ 137/- to ₹ 176/-. Important decisions taken in the 177th meeting of ESIC includes reduction in rate of ESI contribution by employees and employers, increasing the income limit for dependency of the dependent parents of an IP for availing medical facilities, to bear the full cost of ESI Scheme in the prescribed ceiling of per IP expenditure, to set up 500 bedded ESIC Model Hospital at Sheela Nagar, Visakhapatnam, up-gradation of ESI Dispensaries into 30 bedded ESI Hospitals, formation of sub-committee to decide the quantum of enhancement of PDB/ DB rates etc.

For providing better medical facilities to the Insured Persons and their family members, to mention a few, the renovated and upgraded 100 bedded ESI Hospital, Bhubaneswar and OPD Wing of ESIC AYUSH Hospital at Narela, Delhi were inaugurated; foundation stone for 3 ESIC Dispensaries at Mayur Vihar Phase-I, Noida Phase-II and Sector -22, Noida were laid and also Hon'ble PM dedicated to the nation ESIC Medical College & PGIMSR and 500 bedded Hospital, Rajajai Nagar, ESIC Medical College & 500 bedded Hospital, Faridabad (Haryana) and ESIC Medical College, PGIMSR & 470 bedded ESIC Hospital, K.K. Nagar, Chennai.

Let us take forward these initiatives in a mission mode to provide better and hassle free service to the Insured Persons.

I appeal to all ESICians to keep in mind that the motto of ESIC is to provide better and hassle free service and be a responsible organization answerable to all Stakeholders.

Let us all move ahead to make the year 2019 really outstanding with more dedication and hard work.

A Historical decision **Contribution to ESI Scheme reduced**

n a historical decision taken by Government of India, the overall rate of contribution to ESI Scheme is reduced from 6.5% to 4%. The new rate of contribution has come into effect from 01.07.2019. Now the employers' contribution is 3.25% against the earlier contribution rate of 4.75% and contribution of the Insured persons is 0.75% against the earlier rate of 1.75%. This move by the Government is a big financial relief to 3.6 crore Insured Persons and 12.85 lakh employers. The rate has been reduced after a long period of 22 years.

With the reduction of ESIC contribution rate, ESIC ensures the Insured Persons and their beneficiaries that there will be no change or reduction in the existing benefits being provided to them under ESI Scheme. ESIC is committed to provide better and hassle free service to the Insured Persons and other stakeholders for which it has already launched many initiatives in the past. ESIC will take forward all the initiatives in a mission mode and will also launch new initiatives from time to time.

It is expected that the reduction in rate will facilitate further enrolment of workers under ESI Scheme and bring more workforce into the formal sector. On the other hand, the reduced financial liability of the employers will lead to improved viability for running their business without much financial burden. They will be in a position to provide improved facilities to the workforce and will also improve compliance of provisions under ESI Act.

Government of India is committed to the cause of welfare of employees as well as employers. ESIC is also committed to improve the quality of medical services & other benefits being provided under the ESI Scheme.

ESIC has achieved many milestones under the guidance of the Hon'ble Minister during his previous tenure as Minister of State (Independent Charge), Ministry of Labour and Employment and Chairman, ESIC.

ESIC assures the Hon'ble Minister that the measures in the social security sector for ensuring a healthy workforce already initiated by him during his earlier tenure will be taken forward and ESIC will relentlessly work for ensuring social security to millions of workforce covered under ESI Scheme.



176th Meeting of ESIC

ESIC conducted its 176th meeting on 05.12.2018 under the Chairmanship of Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar, Hon'ble Minister of State for Labour & Employment (Independent Charge).

The other dignitaries who attended the meeting were Shri Heeralal Samariya, IAS, Secretary, Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, Shri Raj Kumar, IAS, Director General, ESIC, Shri Manish Gupta, IAS, the then Jt. Secretary, Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, Ms. Sandhya Shukla, IA & AS, Financial Commissioner, ESIC, Ms. Garima Bhagat, IRS, CVO, ESIC, Representatives of Employees and Employers and Hon'ble Members of ESI Corporation, representatives of State Governments and Officers of MoL&E and ESIC.

Important decisions taken in the meeting:

- It was decided to allow Non-IPs to avail medical services from underutilized ESIC Hospitals after levying User Charges at a subsidized cost of ₹ 10/- for OPD Consultation, at 25% of CGHS package rates for IPD and to provide medicines on actual rate initially for one year on pilot basis. This will immensely help common people to get quality medical care at very low cost and will ensure full utilization of resources of underutilized ESIC Hospitals.
- P) Keeping in view the rise in the National Floor Level Minimum Wages to ₹176/-, decision was taken to enhance the exemption limit for payment of employees' share of contribution from ₹137/to ₹176/-.

- 3) Recruitment under process to various 5200 posts / cadres in ESIC was discussed in the meeting. All were apprised that the posts for which recruitment process has started/likely to start are that of Social Security Officer (539 vacancies), Insurance Medical Officer Grade-II (771 vacancies), Junior Engineers (79 vacancies), Teaching Faculty- Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors (206 vacancies), Specialists Gr. II (330 vacancies) and UDC & Steno (500 vacancies).
- 4) The audited Annual Accounts of ESIC for the year 2017-18 alongwith the Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India and draft Annual Report for the year 2017-18 were adopted for forwarding to Central Government.
- 5) To meet the shortage of specialist/super specialist doctors in some of the ESIC Hospitals, approval was accorded for hiring full time contractual specialists/ super specialists in the department of Anaesthesia, Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, Gyne, Ortho, Cardiology, Nephrology and Medical Oncology after inviting open tender.

Besides the above, 20 other Agenda Items pertaining to improvement in services/benefits to Insured Persons and other administrative matter were deliberated upon and approved during the meeting.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.

"ESI Corporation की 176वीं Meeting में हमारे मंत्रालय के सचिव श्री हीरालाल सामरिया जी, ट्रेड यूनियन के हमारे साथीगण, Employer Association के प्रतिनिधिगण, राज्य सरकारों के अधिकारीगण एवं ESIC की हमारी Team के Officers, आप सभी का स्वागत है। इस मीटिंग में Main Booklet व Supplementary Booklet को मिलाकर कुल 25 Items हैं जिनमें से 16 Agenda Items हैं व 9 Reporting Items हैं।

सर्वप्रथम पिछली 175वीं मीटिंग के Minutes confirm कराये जायेंगे व Action Taken Report रखी जायेगी। इसके अलावा वर्ष 2017–18 के Audited Annual Accounts भी आपके समक्ष Agenda item no. 3 में रखे गये हैं। वर्ष 2017–18 की Draft Annual Report भी item no. 4 में रखी गई है।

जैसा कि आपको ज्ञात हो कि पिछली 175वीं मीटिंग में Reliance को ESIC के Portfolio Manager के रूप में appoint करने संबंधी Agenda item को आप लोगों द्वारा पास किया गया है। उसी क्रम में Item No. 5 में रिजर्व बैंक के पास SGL Account खोलने के लिए एक प्रस्ताव आपके समक्ष लाया गया है। Item No. 6 में ESIC के

मानिकतला (कोलकाता) स्थित Post Graduate Medical College को जोका (कोलकाता) स्थित Medical College में Shift एवं विलय करने संबंधी प्रस्ताव आपके समक्ष रखा गया है।

जैसा कि आपको ज्ञात है कि ESIC की अप्रैल, 2015 को हुई 165वीं मीटिंग में यह प्रस्ताव पास किया गया था कि भविष्य में ESIC कोई भी नया Medical College (या Institute) चालू नहीं करेगी, हालांकि चालू हो चुके या बन रहे Projects को Continue रखा जायेगा। ESIC के Gulbarga स्थित Medical परिसर में आज की तारीख में एक Medical College, एक Dental College व एक Nursing College चल रहे हैं एवं इस परिसर में एक Para Medical College खोलने के लिए भी पर्याप्त infrastructure है, जो खाली पड़ा है। तो एक प्रस्ताव आपके समक्ष इस आशय से item no. 7 में लाया गया है कि Corporation से इस बात का approval, एक exception के रूप में लिया जाये, कि वहां खाली पड़े infrastructure पर एक Para Medical Institue या फिर एक AYUSH Institute खोला जा सके। तो आप सभी लोग इस पर अपने विचार दें।

Item no. 9 में एक विषय इस बात को लेकर भी आपके समक्ष है कि non-IPs को जहां भी ESIC से सुविधायें दी जाएं तो उनसे User Charges लिए जाएं | इसके अतिरिक्त बरेली व वाराणसी स्थित ESIC Hospitals की सेवाएं Non-IPs के लिए भी खोलने से संबंधित प्रस्ताव आपके समक्ष Item No. 10 पर रखा गया है | चूंकि वहां IPs की संख्या कम है, अतः मैं समझता हूं कि यदि अन्य लोगों को भी इन Hospitals की स्वास्थ्य सेवायें एक Nominal Payment देकर मिलें तो अच्छा ही रहेगा एवं ESIC के resource का भी पूर्ण उपयोग हो पायेगा |

इसके अतिरिक्त कुछ Supplementary Agenda items भी हैं जैसे, Supplementary item no. 1 में ESIC के मेडिकल Colleges में Under Graduate Courses में admission हेतु IPs के Wards के लिए जो Policy है उसमें Revision का प्रस्ताव है। इसमें हमें यह विचार भी करना है कि Kerala High Court के अगस्त 2018 के Order के विरुद्ध Suprem Court में SLP दाखिल की जाए या नहीं, तो इस विषय को भी आप सभी लोग देख लें।

Supplementary Item No. 2 जोका (कोलकाता) स्थित Hospital के Contract Workers के वेतन से संबंधित है, जो आपके समक्ष रखा गया है। जैसा कि आपको ज्ञात है कि ESIC द्वारा उन कर्मचारियों से Employee Contribution नहीं लिया जाता है जो प्रतिदिन 137 / – रुपये तक कमाते हैं। आप ही में से कुछ सदस्यों की यह मांग रही हैं कि इस 137 /— रुपये की Limit को बढ़ाया जाए। इसलिए आज हम Supplementary Item No. 3 में इस Limit को बढ़ाकर 176 /— रुपये प्रतिदिन करने का प्रस्ताव आपके समक्ष लाए हैं। मैं समझता हूँ कि IPs के हित में यह अच्छा कदम होगा।

Supplementary Item no. 4 में ESIC के मेडिकल Officers को उच्च शिक्षा के लिए Study Leave दिए जाने संबंधी एक Policy आप लोगों के समक्ष रखी गयी है। Supplementary Item no. 5 में Contract Basis पर Specialists एवं Super Specialists रखे जाने से संबंधित प्रस्ताव आपके समक्ष अनुमोदन हेतु रखा जा रहा है। मैं समझता हूँ कि इससे हम अपने IPs को बेहतर सेवाएं दे पाएंगे। Supplementary Item no. 6 में Hospitals के लिए equipment खरीदने के लिए Financial ceiling में छूट संबंधी Agenda भी आपके समक्ष है।

इसके अतिरिक्त कुछ Reporting Items व Supplementary Reporting Items भी आपके समक्ष रखे गये हैं। ESIC द्वारा 5 हज़ार से अधिक लोगों की विभिन्न संवर्गों में जो नियुक्ति प्रक्रिया चल रही है उसके संबंध में एक Reporting Item आपके समक्ष No. 4 पर रखा गया है। मैं समझता हूं कि यह एक अच्छा प्रयास है एवं इस प्रक्रिया को जल्दी पूरा किया जाए ताकि हम अपने IPs को बेहतर सुविधायें दे पायें।

अब DG महोदय आपके समक्ष इन Agendas का Items-wise ब्यौरा प्रस्तुत करेंगे। मैं चाहूंगा कि आप सभी लोग इन्हें ध्यान से सुनें और इन पर अपनी राय भी व्यक्त करें। हमारी यह कोशिश होनी चाहिए कि IPs के हित में हम कुछ अच्छे निर्णय ले पायें।

177th Meeting of ESIC - Important decisions taken to improve its service delivery mechanism

n the 177th meeting of ESIC held on 19.02.2019 under the Chairmanship of Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Labour & Employment (Independent Charge), many important decisions were taken to improve services under ESI Scheme.

The other dignitaries participated in the meeting were Shri Heeralal Samariya, IAS, Secretary, Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, Shri Raj Kumar, IAS, Director General, ESIC, Smt. Anuradha Prasad, Addl. Secretary, Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, Smt. Sibani Swain, AS & FA, Labour & Employment, Govt. of India and Ms. Sandhya Shukla, IA&AS, Financial Commissioner, ESIC, Representatives of Employees and Employers and Hon'ble ESI Corporation Members, representatives of State Governments and ESIC.

Important decisions taken in the meeting:

- Reduction in rate of ESI Contribution: In the meeting, it was informed that Govt. has approved the reduction in the rate of contribution being paid by employers and employees from 4.75% to 4% and 1.75% to 1% respectively of the wages, and a draft notification intending to reduce the rate of contribution has been issued by Govt. of India on 15.02.2019. Reduction in contribution will benefit all the employees and employers covered under ESI Scheme.
- 2) Proposal for increasing the income limit for dependency of the dependent parents of an Insured Person for availing Medical Benefit : The Income limit for availing medical benefit for the dependent parents of an Insured Person covered under ESI Scheme has been enhanced from the existing ₹5000/- per month from all sources to ₹9000/- per month.
- 3) ESIC to bear full cost of ESI Scheme in the prescribed

ceiling of per IP expenditure : In order to improve the medical service delivery in the states, It was decided that ESIC will also bear the $1/8^{th}$ share of expenditure earlier used to be borne by States. Till now, ESIC used to bear $7/8^{th}$ share of expenses of ESI Scheme. With this decision, ESIC will bear the full cost of ESI Scheme in the prescribed ceiling of per IP expenditure for a period of three years beginning from 2019-20.

- 4) Setting up of 500 bedded ESIC Model Hospital at Sheelanagar, Visakhapatnam : ESIC will acquire an additional land of 10.56 acres abutting already allotted land of 8.58 acre at Sheelanagar, Visakhapatnam. On this land, 500 bedded ESIC Model Hospital with Super Specialties will be constructed.
- 5) Upgradation of ESI Dispensary to 30 bedded ESI Hospital : To bridge the gap in indoor health care facilities, in principle approval to Report of Sub-Committee on reconsideration of policy for upgradation of ESI Dispensary to 30 bedded ESI Hospital was accorded. Now, the 30 bedded ESI Hospitals will be established on 20000 IPs population in plain area and 15000 IPs population in hilly areas. Earlier, ESIC was setting up hospitals only in such areas where minimum IPs population was 50000. This decision will provide indoor facilities to IPs/beneficiaries in several underserved implemented areas under ESI Scheme.
- 6) Sub-Committee formed to decide the quantum of enhancements of PDB/DB rates : ESIC has been periodically enhancing the basic rates of the PDB and DB payments to counter the effect of inflation. To compensate for inflation, a Sub-Committee of ESIC has been formed to decide on the methodology and quantum of enhancement of the PDB/DB rates.
- 7) Starting of DOTT and DMRT Courses : It was also decided in the meeting that ESIC will start paramedical courses of Diploma in OT Technology (DOTT) and Diploma in Medical Records Technology (DMRT) at its Hospital & College complex, Gulbarga. In line with Skill India Mission, these courses will help in bridging the gap in the availability of trained paramedical manpower.

Besides above, around 40 other agenda items pertaining to improvement in services/benefits to Insured Persons and their beneficiaries and other administrative matters were deliberated upon and approved during the meeting.

मित्रों, ईएसआईसी की 177वीं बैठक में आप सभी का मैं स्वागत करता हूँ। मैं कारपोरेशन के उन सभी सदस्यों का बहुत—बहुत स्वागत करता हूँ कि अपना अमूल्य समय निकाल कर इस बैठक में सम्मिलित हुए। मुझे ध्यान आ रहा है कि श्रम मंत्रालय के मेरे कार्यकाल के दौरान अब तक कारपोरेशन की पांच बैठकें हुई है और आज यह इसकी छठवीं बैठक है। मैं महसूस करता हूँ कि मेरे इस कार्यकाल की संभवतः क्योंकि लगता है कि 10 दिन के बाद आचार संहिता लग जाएगी तो यह आखिरी

बैठक होगी। इस दौरान मुझे आप सभी लोगों का बहुत सहयोग मिला। मैं आप सबका प्रारंभ में ही धन्यवाद देना चाहूंगा और मैं महसूस करता हूँ कि बहुत ही ऐसे जिम्मेदार लोग हैं जिनकी देश और देश के बाहर ख्याति है, उनके साथ में रहने से बहुत कुछ समझने का हमको एक अवसर मिला, मौका मिला। और मैंने यह भी महसूस किया कि सामान्यतः सारे फैसले हमने सर्वसम्मत लिए और यह बात सही है कि कुछ मुद्दों पर अगर मतभेद भी रहा तो हम लोगों ने मिलकर उन बातों को सुलझाने का काम किया।

हम सभी लोगों ने बहुत से महत्वपूर्ण निर्णय लिए। अटल बीमित व्यक्ति कल्याण योजना चालू की गई और जैसा अभी बताया कि लोगों को लाभ मिलना शुरू हो गया है | नरेला में आयूष का एक अस्पताल खोला गया जो पूरे देश का एक पहला और अनूठा प्रयास है और मैं धन्यवाद देना चाहूगा कि जिस प्रकार से कोशिश यहां पर की गई, हमने उसकी शुरुआत की है, तो मैं बहुत—बहुत धन्यवाद दूंगा कि उस दिशा में हमने काम की शुरुआत की है जो वास्तव में लोगों की अपेक्षा के अनुरूप था। बहुत सारे हमने Hospitals और Medical institutions के projects भी पूरे किए, और कई शिलान्यास भी किए । और मैं समझता हूँ कि विगत वर्षों में हमने जो प्रयास किए थे हमारे IPs को और बेहतर सुविधाएं मिल सकें उसके हिसाब से हम लोग काम कर रहे हैं और उसमें आप सब लोगों ने निरंतर सहयोग किया। तो मैं यहां उल्लेख करना चाहूगा कि डॉक्टर त्रिगुणा जी, वैध जी कह रहे थे कि भई आयुर्वेद का जो काम हमने शुरू किया है इसको देश के अंदर एक मॉडल के रूप में हम शुरू करने का काम करें। जैसे दिल्ली में लोग AIIMS की चिंता करते हैं वैसे कम से कम ईएसआईसी का एक आयुर्वेद का अस्पताल देश के अंदर अपनी पहचान बनाने का काम करेगी, एक अच्छी दिशा में हम लोग काम कर रहे हैं | मुझे लगता है कि आने वाले समय में हम इसको और सही ढंग से ले जाने का काम करेंगे | तो आप सब लोगों ने जो सहयोग दिया मैं एक बार फिर से इसके लिए आप लोगों को धन्यवाद देना चाहूंगा।

जैसा अभी बताया गया कि इस मीटिंग में 10 agenda items, 14 reporting items, 6 supplementary items और 14 supplementary reporting items हैं, दो बुकलेट में हम लोगों की रुचि रहेगी। मुझे ध्यान है कि 176वीं मीटिंग जो हमने दिसम्बर 18 में की थी उस मीटिंग को हम confirm भी करेंगे और Action Taken Report वर्ष 18–19 के revise Estimates और वर्ष 19–20 के Budget Estimates o Performance Budget सहित उस सभी agenda items पर चर्चा करेंगे जो हमारे IPs के हित से सम्बन्धित हैं।

जैसा कि आप सब जानते हैं कि hospital construction एवं इससे जुड़े व्यय के लिए एक reserved fund की व्यवस्था की गई है जिसमें लगभग 8815 करोड रुपये एकत्रित हो चुके हैं और इसमें अभी हमारे सामने 2913 करोड़ रुपये चालू और नए प्रोजेक्ट में लगने हैं। इसके पश्चात भी लगभग 6000 करोड़ रुपये इस फण्ड में शेष बचेंगे। इनका उपयोग भविष्य के नये प्रोजेक्ट्स पर किया जायेगा। अतः एक प्रस्ताव इस आशय से आपके समक्ष लाया जा रहा है agenda no. 4 में इसके तहत फण्ड में अगले पांच वर्ष तक नया पैसा ना डाला जाए। मैं समझता हूँ कि 6000 करोड़ रुपये एक अच्छी खासी रकम है और भविष्य में इन projects पर मुझे लगता है कि हम तेजी से काम करें और जब जरूरत हो तो हम पैसा ले। डॉक्टरों को Study leave देने से संबंधित agenda item no. 5 में है और item no. 6 में आश्रित माता—पिता को ईएसआईसी के medical benefits दिलाने के लिए उसकी wage limit संबंधित पात्रता जो ₹5000 प्रति माह थी, इसको बढ़ाकर ₹9000 प्रति माह करने का भी एक एजेंडे में प्रस्ताव रखा गया है जिससे कि IPs के बुजुर्ग माता—पिता के हित में, मैं समझता हूँ कि अच्छे ढंग से हम लोग काम कर सके।

एक महत्वपूर्ण मुद्दा जो आपके समक्ष आ चुका है 30 बेड के अस्पताल खोलने से सम्बन्धित | चूंकि हम लोगों के संज्ञान में है कि 30 बेड का अस्पताल खोलना वित्तीय रूप से व्यवहार्य नहीं हो पा रहा था | अतः 175वीं बैठक में इससे संबंधित एजेंडा आपके समक्ष लाया गया था | परंतु IPs के हित में कुछ members ये चाहते थे कि 30 बेड के अस्पताल खोले जाएं | आपकी भावनाओं को ध्यान में रखते हुए हमने एक Sub committee मंत्रालय के अतिरिक्त सचिव की अध्यक्षता में बनाई थी | Sub committee ने IPs की स्वास्थ्य सुविधाओं को ध्यान में रखते हुए 20,000 से अधिक IPs वाले क्षेत्रों में और पहाड़ी क्षेत्रों में यह संख्या 15000 से अधिक होगी, 30 बेड के अस्पताल खोलने की अनुशंसा की है | इसलिए agenda item no. 8 में यह मुद्दा पुनः आपके आपके समक्ष है |

Item no. 9 में UTIITSL के साथ agreement को renew करने संबंधी एजेंडा रखा गया है। इसके अतिरिक्त कुछ supplementary items भी हैं इनमें item no. 5 permanent disability benefit एवं आश्रित हितलाभ को बढ़ाने के लिए एक Sub committee बनाने का प्रस्ताव आपके समक्ष लाया गया है। मैं समझता हूं कि इस विषय पर हम उपयुक्त कार्य करें और जल्दी निर्णय लें, यह आवश्यक है। एक विषय यह भी है कि Societies का Chairman कौन हो, संबंधित मंत्री हो या Chief Secretary इस संदर्भ में कुछ बातचीत चल रही है।

तो मैं आप सबका बहुत—बहुत स्वागत करता हूं और वास्तव में, कैसे IPs को हम ज्यादा से ज्यादा लाभ पहुंचा सकें और हमें ध्यान है कि आदरणीय प्रधानमंत्री जी की रुचि इसमें है और हम जिस जिम्मेदारी से काम करते हैं क्योंकि निसंजी एक ऐसा विषय है जोकि केंद्र और राज्य दोनों के बीच का है | और प्रधानमंत्री जी जिस प्रकार से योजना चला रहे हैं क्योंकि आयुष्मान योजना जो हम सब लोगों ने सुनी हैं और उसके बाद अब हमारा मंत्रालय भी योजना चला रहा है, उसका उल्लेख में करना नहीं चाहुंगा, संदर्भ यहां पर नहीं है, पर देश का कोई व्यक्ति इससे बाहर बचेगा नहीं, ऐसा हमको लगता है । और हमारी कोशिश यही है कि कैसे अधिकतम सुविधा हम लोगों को पहुंचा सकें ? तो सारे प्रदेशों और राज्यों के स्वास्थ्य मंत्रालय इस दिशा में काम कर रहे हैं, पर मैं अभी थोड़ी देर पहले बोल रहा था, कि ईएसआईसी के बारे में लोग अच्छी राय रखें और लोगों को ये विश्वास रहें कि ईएसआई के अस्पताल संबंधित राज्य के अस्पताल के मुकाबले ज्यादा लाभप्रद हैं। तो हमारा मानना है कि हम ऐसी स्थिति बनाएं क्योंकि हमने कुछ अस्पतालों में जहां पर IPs की संख्या कम है, आम आदमी के लिए भी खोला गया है। हमारी प्रतिष्ठा बढे, लोग हमारे पास आना पसंद करें, हमसे इलाज कराना पसंद करें, हमारे पास दवा और इलाज के लिए पैसे की कमी नहीं है ऐसा हम सब जानते हैं। तो मैं आप सबके सुझाव आज इस संदर्भ में आमंत्रित करता हूँ । और एक बार फिर से आप सबका बहुत—बहुत आभार व्यक्त करते हुए कि आप सब लोग यहां पर आए और अब DG महोदय agenda wise आप लोगों से बात करेंगे और उसके बाद भी अगर आप साथी लोग कुछ बताना चाहते हैं तो आपका बहुत—बहुत स्वागत है।

Standing Committee Meetings of ESIC

212th Meeting held on 04.12.2018

The meeting chaired by Secretary, Ministry of Labour & Employment as well as Chairman, Standing Committee of ESIC was attended by Members of ESIC, Director General ESIC, officers from Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, representatives of various state governments and senior officers of ESIC.

Director General, ESIC welcomed all the participants in the meeting. In his welcome address, DG, ESIC apprised the members that this meeting has been held mainly for seeking approval of the Audited Annual Account and Annual Report of ESIC for the year 2017-18. He also advised to go in an aggressive mode to provide better services to the IPs so that they should feel the difference in getting better facilities compared to other hospitals. He also said that if required, more power may be delegated at regional level for



DG, ESIC welcoming the members of Standing Committee efficient delivery of services to the IPs.

The following decisions were taken in the meeting:

- The minutes of the 211th meeting of the Standing Committee held on 12.07.2018 was confirmed in the meeting.
- The Action Taken Report on the recommendations/ decisions of the last meeting of the Committee held on 12.07.2018 was accepted by the members of the Standing Committee.
- Financial Commissioner, ESIC made a presentation on the Audited Annual Accounts of ESIC for the year 2017-18 along with the report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India. DG, ESIC addressed the queries raised by Shri V. Radhakrishnan, Member, ESIC regarding the spurt in contribution income during 2017-18 and apparent decrease of cash benefits during the same period. After detailed discussion, the Audited Annual

Accounts for the year 2017-18 together with the report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India was approved by the Committee for placing before the 176^{th} meeting of ESIC to be held on 05.12.2018 for adoption and approval.

- The Draft Annual Report for the year 2017-18 and analysis thereof was approved by the Committee.
- The Committee approved the proposal for purchase of land measuring 9.08 acres for construction of proposed 100 bedded ESI Hospital at Bawal, Haryana.
- Approval was accorded to the proposal for recommending to the Corporation (i) opening of Subsidiary General Ledger (SGL) Account/s with Reserve Bank of India for investment / transactions in the Government Securities and (ii) operation of SGL Account/s through the portfolio manager M/s. Reliance Nippon Life Assets Management Limited or any other portfolio manager appointed in future.
- Regarding IT roll-out Project Panchdeep continuation of O&M of Project Panchdeep beyond 08.03.2019, the Committee approved the proposal for extension of O & M contract with RailTel for 3 more months up to 08.06.2019.
- The item regarding execution of Annual Repair & Maintenance (ARM) and Special Repairs (SR) works for hospital / dispensaries was discussed, but it was not approved by the Committee. However, it was decided that if needed, the matter may be placed before the Corporation for its consideration.

Besides the above, the members of the Standing Committee delebrated upon the contents of the reporting as well as supplementary reporting items.

213th Meeting held on 23.01.2019

Shri Raj Kumar, DG, ESIC welcomed the Chairman and members of the Standing Committee and informed the gathering that there are 9 Agenda Items and 17 Reporting Items and the most important agenda items are Revised Estimates for the year 2018-19 and Budget estimates for the year 2019-20 which are already recommended by the Budget and Accounts Sub Committee on 21.01.2019. DG informed about the unfortunate fire incident occurred at ESIC Hospital & PGIMSR, Andheri (E), Maharashtra in which 13 persons lost their lives and to pay respect to the departed souls, 2 minutes silence was observed by all the members. He also informed that ex-gratia has been released to the families of the IPs who lost their lives and to all the injured persons.

Before taking up the agenda, the Chairman, Standing Committee expressed deep concern about the fate of students pursuing PG course from ESIC Hospital & PGIMSR,

Andheri (E), Maharashtra where classes have been discontinued, as the hospital building is totally vacated due to the fire incident and gave direction to take suitable actions immediately. To this, DG apprised the Chairman that ESIC has already written letter to the Secretary, Medical Education, Govt. of Maharashtra as well as to MCI and informed that that there is a provision to shift these students to other Maharashtra Govt. recognized PG Medical Colleges in exceptional case. The Committee was also briefed about the ESIC PGIMSR Hospital, Andheri (E),

Maharashtra incident and the measures taken to restore the facilities in the hospital after completion of necessary works.

The following decisions were taken in the meeting:

- The minutes of the 212th meeting of the Standing Committee held on 04.12.2018 was confirmed in the meeting
- After considering the observations of various Members and DMS, Tamil Nadu, Action Taken Report on the recommendations / decisions of the last meeting of the Standing Committee held on 04.12.2018 was accepted by the Committee.
- After detailed deliberations on the presentation and information given by Financial Commissioner, ESIC, the Revised Estimates for the year 2018-19, Budget Estimates for the year 2019-20 and Performance Budget for the year 2019-20 were approved and recommended for placing before the Corporation for adoption and members were told to send any suggestion/observation within a week.
- Regarding waiver of bond amount of ₹25 lakh in respect of Dr. Meenakshi Sharma, P.G. Student of ESIC -PGIMSR Basaidarpur, New Delhi in MD (Anesthesia) course who is unable to complete the course due to her family circumstances, the Chairman directed to form a Committee of ESIC Officers to examine the

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genuineness of the fact.

- The Committee approved the proposal for construction of 200 bedded ESI Hospital at Bhilai, Chhattisgarh
- The proposal for engagement of Consultants was approved by the Committee

In addition to the above various supplementary agendas were also discussed in the meeting and accorded approval.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

214th Meeting held on 29.03. 2019

Welcoming the Chairman and members of the Standing Committee, Shri Raj Kumar, Director General, ESIC informed that ESIC has taken some important decisions which have helped in improving the delivery of service to the IPs and their dependant family members. He informed that the agenda items placed for the meeting includes standardization of manpower deployment, procurement of dispensary kit to all dispensaries which was given as a part of the ESIC's diamond jubilee celebration in 2011 which will be replaced by new kit, issue of Health Passbook to the ESI beneficiaries etc. He also informed about launching of Unified Website 'www.esic.nic.in' for ESIC Offices,

Decisions taken in the meeting:

- The follow-up Agenda Item of waiver of bond amount in respect of Dr. Meenakshi Sharma, P.G. Student of ESIC-PGIMSR, Basaidarapur, New Delhi in MD (Anesthesia) course was not approved by the Committee as Chairman of the Committee stated that there is no justified ground to consider the matter.
- The Committee deferred the agenda Item of Report of the Sub-Committee on Consolidation and Re-Organization of Sub-Regional Office until the next meeting of the Committee.
- The Committee approved the Agenda Item regarding approval of revised estimate for repairs/ renovation/ upgradation of ESIC Model Hospital, Sahibabad, Ghaziabad

After deliberations on the observation raised by Dr. K.K. Agrawal, Shri V.Radhakrishnan, Dr. Nitin S. Vora and Shri P.N. Chowdhury, all Members of the Committee, the agenda point on standardization of manpower development in hospitals for maintenance of building service was approved.

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Director General exhorts to take forward the Structural Reforms of ESIC to meet the end goals

A conference was organised for Regional Directors, Medical Superintendents, SMOs, Engineers under the Chairmanship of Shri Raj Kumar, Director General, ESIC on 12th and 13th March, 2019 at New Delhi. Various agenda points on the functioning of ESIC were discussed during the conference.

Shri A.K. Sinha, Insurance Commissioner welcomed all the delegates and requested the participants to work collectively for achieving various objectives of ESIC.

Welcoming the gathering, Director General said that ESIC has undergone structural reforms and RDs are required to lead the team ESIC in their respective States and all efforts should be made to provide better facilities to IPs so as to align with the objectives of ESIC in coordination with all ESIC establishments in their respective area. He also said that ESIC institutions, whether hospitals, dispensaries, branch offices, SROs should be functioning in coordination with each other and only then the quality services could be provided to the IPs. He also emphasized that there are so many issues with the structure, infrastructure, finance etc. of State Governments which need to be supplemented by ESIC to make its services better.

After the address of DG, the agenda items fixed for the

meeting were taken up for detailed discussion. Following agenda items were discussed and deliberated upon:

- Recruitment
- IT related matters
- PMD related matters
- Public Grievance
- Establishment and general administration related matters
- · Finance and Accounts related matters
- Revenue, Revenue Recovery and cash benefit related matters
- Vigilance

The concerned officers looking after various agenda points discussed in detail and the participants also expressed their views. After hearing the deliberations, Director General expressed his views and directed the concerned officers to take appropriate action.

Improved Services the need of the hour for taking forward ESI Scheme

The meeting of Regional Directors, Medical Superintendents, SMOs, Engineers chaired by Shri Raj Kumar, Director General, ESIC was held on 21st and 22nd December, 2018 at New Delhi.

Insurance Commissioner welcomed all the participants and urged them to have a fruitful discussion on various agenda items identified.

Welcoming all the participants, Director General urged all present in the meeting to work tirelessly to give optimum service to the IPs and other stakeholders. DG desired that ESIC has to improve its services to the IPs who have to approach the state government to get medical and cash benefits respectively and ESIC cannot absolve its responsibility of providing medical care, which otherwise has been relegated to state domain as 'Health' in the State List. DG observed that ESIC's services / infrastructure is not keeping pace with the expansion of IP base and for achieving this, ESIC has to not only improve its medical infrastructure but also rationalize tie-up with private hospitals / institutions and opined that opening of DCBOs is one such step as it can deliver primary and secondary medical services. DG also pointed out that due to not so regular process of recruitment and retirement of officers and staffs. ESIC is facing shortage of manpower in administrative and medical areas and informed that recruitment drive is underway. He instructed the Medical Superintendents to identify specialists who should be hired at market rates for providing better services to IPs.

After the brief address of DG, active discussions were held on the following agenda items

- Medical Benefit related matters
- Revenue, Revenue Recovery and cash benefit related matters
- Finance and Accounts related matters
- PMD related matters
- Recruitment, Establishment and General Administration related matters
- Public Grievance
- IT related matters
- Vigilance related matters

Shri Heeralal Samariya, Secretary, Labour & Employment, Govt. of India addressed the RD's Conference. Smt. Anuradha Prasad, Addl. Secretary was also present during the meeting.

RDs, MSs, SMOs, and Engineers actively participated and put forward their observations/ suggestions. For each agenda point discussed, Director General put forward his suggestions and views and directed the concerned officers to take immediate action based on the deliberations and decisions taken in the meeting.

month wise is given below.

Important points discussed on various days during January, 2019

- A Committee consisting of Shri A.P. Tripathi, AC (Bft), Dr. Subhash Chokra, DMC, Shri A.K. Sahu, Director (Legal) and Shri K.G. Suresh, Jt. Director (E-I) was formed to have consultation with State Govt. for On Account Payment to States
- Action to be taken to present data relating to repairs required in self-owned dispensaries for taking up repairs and construction activity
- DMC (Dhanwantari) was directed to take action to finalise online provison for availing medical services
- MC was directed to submit progress report of shifting Branch Office to hospitals for opening DCBO in these hospitals.
- After detailed discussions on store management in hospitals, Kendriya Bhandar local purchase issue and the complaint being made by Pharmacists, DG desired CVO to call for papers relating to the case to examine from preventive vigilance angle
- About linking PDB/DB, it was decided to link it with CPI and IC (Benefit) has to take action
- DG asked the Committee on finalizing modality for payment directly to Society to fix date and finalise the modalities
- DG desired to examine the proposal that equipment purchase for ESIS Hospitals may be made by ESIC Hqrs. and given to the States and AMC should be done by ESIC for equipments supplied to the ESIS Hospitals and action to be taken by MC
- The agenda proposed for Standing Committee meeting scheduled for 23.01.2019 was discussed in detail. Among others, two important agenda points discussed were Andheri demolition in fire accident and status of recruitment.

- Besides various agenda points, the important points discussed for the Corporation Meeting scheduled on 19.02.2019 included On Account Payment to States, PDB linking with CPI and study leave for AYUSH.
- Operationalising ₹50, 000/- imprest for MS of ESIS Hospital
- DMC (Dhanwantari) to have prototype of software for Atal Bimit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana by 18th January, 2019
- It was informed that the matter on Aadhaar linking has been sent by MoL&E to Department of Expenditure, MoF and action to be taken by DMC (Dhanwantari)
- Detailed discussions were held on construction / repair work, maintenance, Fire Safety, various issues related to the Corporation meeting on 19.02.2019
- DG suggested to request member of ESIC namely Shri Dinesh Lakra of Udyog Bharti to give details of districts where medical facility is poor and Modified IMP Scheme can be focused on such areas and directed MC for action
- Detailed discussion was held on exempting State from sharing 1/8th expenditure
- DG desired to have a media plan ready for publicity of schmes namely Modified IMP, MEUD, Health Passbook, Atal Beemit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana, reduction in rate of contribution
- About the inspection of ESIC by Rajbhasha Parliamentary Committee, DG said that the performance has not been considered satisfactory and advised to increase the performance and directed IC (Rajbhasha) to impart training to all staff in each branch to operationalise online Apps for better writing/ typing in Hindi

Important points discussed on various days during February, 2019

- Discussions were held on Benefit PDB/DB rate enhancement, Sub-Committee report on society, 30 bedded hospital reports, revision of AYUSH norms, pendency of cash benefit payment, medical arrangement in new areas, Rajbhasha implementation etc. and DG directed the concerned officers to take action
- Discussing on the issues raised by Shri S.Radhakrishnan, Member, ESIC, DG directed the concerned divisional heads to submit their

respective draft reply to Corporate Cell for making a consolidated reply to the Member

- Discussions were held on outsourcing of pharmacy in ESIC/ESIS; shifting of Branch offices to hospitals, opening blood banks in ESIC hospitals, SST for retired IPs, medical instrument availability in dispensary, evaluation of office work in Hindi, Training program for SSOs, Training program for JEs etc. and the concerned officers were directed to take necessary action.
- Decided that distribution of cards and welcome kit for IPs should be made through camps by the Branch Offices.
- Discussed on various points like holding of 214th meeting of the Standing Committee, ATR and agenda items for Standing Committee, SST bill pendency, expeditious clearance of IP reimbursement bill by ESIC, IP bill reimbursement by DCBO, SD –WAN implementation, staffing in ESI hospitals, non-functional modules of Project Panchdeep, prompt payment on GeM, UIDAI Aadhaar linking, purchase of eHospital application from NIC, appointment of second Portfolio Manager for investment, outsourcing of pharmacy in hsospitals, Health Passbook to retired IPs, man-power planning for opening of DCBO, outsourcing of norms for Hospitals etc.

- Discussed on amendment in the Project Panchdeep Module, drugs sale by pharmacist and doctors in the wake of recent case of arrest of a pharmacist from ESIC Hospital, Okhla, outsourcing of pharmacy in hospital, ATR in respect of decisions taken in the last Standing Committee meeting, adverse e-mail being received on DG's mail, bond for pursuing PG course, DNB course in ESIC, reply to the draft Audit Report of ESIC Headquarter Office by CAG etc.
- Discussed various points like Standing Committee meeting agenda items, appointment of Acturary, MEUD functioning, Opening of Jan Aushadhi center in ESIC hospital and ESIS hospital, engagement of part time specialists, operationalizing of ICU/ HDU in ESI hospitals, shifting of SRO Lucknow to ESI Hospital Lucknow building, shifting of PG institute from ESIC hospitals to ESIC Medical Colleges, considering of construction 300 bedded hospital for

- Consultation with UPSC for recruitment to post carrying GP ₹4600 and above, action on decisions taken during 214th meeting of Standing Committee, monthly review of construction projects, underutilized medical college/ hospital of ESIC, opening of ESIC hospitals for people covered under Ayushman Bhrat, review report of MEUD, SST process simplification, rate revision for part time contract faculties of teaching hospitals, medal scheme for ESIC medical college pass outs etc.
- Preventing fire incidents in ESIC, opening of DCBO in the districts based on IPs, empanelment of secondary and tertiary care hospitals, issue of ward of IP Certificate, PDB / DB data analysis, APAR online through SPARROW, deployment of staff nurses and nursing sisters for duty as per the SIU norms, training of F&A Officers posted in field formation etc.
- Discussed issues related to construction / repair of various hospitals, shifting of SRO Noida, biometric attendance of all outsourced staff, purchase of dispensary kit, Unified Website of ESIC, Bidding for second Portfolio Manager, PPP model for nonfunctional ESI Hospitals, review of performance of empanelled hospitals, migration of retired employees data to pensioner module, 100% utilization of the accounts module of Project Panchdeep, interfacing of hospital equipment with Dhanwantri application etc.
- Shifting of ICT Branch to the main Hqrs. building, observation of DG & FC about their visit to Lucknow and Kanpur hospital, signing of integrity pact with construction agencies, repair work of certain hospitals, MEUD performance, equipment procurement, empanelment status of Secondary and Tertiary care hospitals, employer registration on ESIC Portal, status of CPWD projects etc.



Atal Bimit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana (ABVKY)

As per the decision taken in the 175th meeting of ESIC held on 18.09.2018 and in pursuance of the Gazette Notification in Extraordinary Part III Section 4 dated 06.12.20018, ESIC has launched "Atal Bimit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana" to provide relief in the form of cash compensation to the Insured Persons who have been rendered unemployed subject to certain conditions.

This is a welfare measure for employees covered under Section 2(9), in the form of cash compensation up to 90 days, once in a life time, to be claimed after three months in one or more spells for being rendered unemployed, provided the employee should have completed two years of insurable employment and has contributed not less than 78 days in each of the four consecutive contribution periods immediately preceding the claim of the relief. The relief shall not exceed 25% of the average earning per day. The scheme comes in to effect from 01.07.2018 and is implemented on pilot basis initially for a period of two years.

Eligibility conditions

- The IP should have been rendered unemployed during the period the relief is claimed
- The IP should have been in insurable employment for a minimum period of 2 years immediately before unemployment
- The IP should have contributed not less than 78 days during each of the preceding four contribution periods
- The contribution in respect of the IP should have been paid or payable by the employer
- The contingency of the unemployment should not have been as a result of any punishment or misconduct or superannuation or voluntary retirement
- The Aadhaar and Bank account of the IP should be linked with the IP data base.

Other conditions

- In case the IP is working for more than one employer and is covered under the ESI Scheme, the IP will be considered unemployed only in case he is rendered unemployed with all the employers
- As specified in Section 65 of the Act, an IP shall not be entitled to any other cash compensation and the relief under ABVKY simultaneously for the same period. However, periodical payments of PDB under ESI Act and Regulations shall continue.
- As specified under Section 61 of the ESI Act, an IP who is in receipt of relief under ABVKY shall not be entitled to receive any similar benefit admissible under the provisions of any other enactment
- The IP will be eligible for medical benefit as provided

under the Act for the period he/she is availing this relief

Disqualification/Termination of relief under ABVKY

- During lock out
- Strike resorted to by the employees declared illegal by the competent authority
- Voluntary abandonment of employment/ voluntary retirement/permanent retirement
- Less than 2 years of contributory service
- On attaining the age of superannuation
- Convicted (i.e. punished for false statement) under the provisions of Section 84 of the ESI Act read with Rule 62 of the ESI (Central) Rule
- On being re-employed elsewhere during the period the IP is in receipt of relief under ABVKY
- · Dismissal/termination under disciplinary action
- On death of IP

Benefits of the Scheme

Relief to the extent of 25% of the average per day earning (total earning during the four contribution period / 730 days) during the previous four contribution periods to be paid up to maximum 90 days of unemployment once in a life time of the IP on submission of claim in the form of an Affidavit.

The IP should submit the claim for relief under ABVKY anytime after being rendered unemployed, but not later than one year from the date of unemployment to the concerned ESIC Branch Office in the form an affidavit in the prescribed from. No prospective claim under the Scheme for any future period will be allowed. The relief shall be payable by the Branch Office directly to the IPs in their bank account electronically. In the event of death IP, the amount of relief shall be paid/ payable to his/her nominee/ legal heir by account payee cheque only.



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Dispensary-cum-Branch Office (DCBO) - Strengthening of Services

n the 174th meeting of ESIC held on 29.05.2018, approval was accorded for setting up of a Dispensary-cum-Branch Office (DCBO) in every District of the country to make the presence of ESIC for primary care service in each district. This was a brainchild of Director General, ESIC to strengthen the functioning of ESIC and to deliver multiple services under one roof.

To begin with, DCBO's has been started in 29 districts in 20 states and these are functioning smoothly. Gradually, DCBO will be extended in all districts of the country. To make presence of DCBO in each district, all Regional Offices and Sub Regional Offices have been given target to open

and issued guidelines in this regard vide its Memorandum dated 24.04.2019 which is available on the website esic.nic.in under Circular tab.

Functioning of Dispensary in DCBO

- OPD service to the beneficiaries
- On-line referral of beneficiary for Secondary or Tertiary medical care (SST) to the ESIC Hospital or private Empanelled Hospital.
- Generation of P-1 form for referral to the Private Tie-up Hospital for Secondary as well as Tertiary Medical Care(SST) in case of patient referred by MEUD, modified IMP, IMP and ESIS Dispensary for Secondary/Tertiary



Dispensary-cum-Branch Office, Ghatshila (Jharkhand)

DCBO in all the districts falling under their jurisdiction immediately, so that the target can be achieved.

DCBO will function as a single destination for IP/IW to avail cash as well as Medical Benefit available under ESI Scheme. DCBO will not only provide primary medical care to the IP but also refer the IP for secondary as well as Super Speciality Treatment (SST), if needed. To provide the medical care to the beneficiaries hassle-free, the Corporation has decided to bear 100% expenditure towards the establishment as well as operational cost of DCBO.

The DCBO will function under the control of Regional Director of the concerned state and will be managed by 1 Doctor for 3000 IP/ 50 OPD, 2 Doctors for 50-150 OPD and 3 Doctors for more than 150 OPD along with ANM/Dresser, Pharmacist. It has also been decided to deploy 1 Asstt. Director in case of more than 20000 IP attached with DCBO along with 1 SSO, 1 Assistant and 2 UDC.

ESIC Hqrs. Office has clarified various doubts raised by Regions/Sub-Regions about the functioning of the DCBO

Medical Care.

- Distribution of medicines by Dispensary and in case of non-availability through Empanelled Chemist.
- Reimbursement of medical Bills of Beneficiary of Medicine, lab testing charges outside approved list medicines and lab test.
- Verification of claim submitted by MEUD, EUD, Modified IMP and IMP
- Verification of Bills received from Empanelled Chemist and laboratory attached with the DCBO.
- Verification of Secondary Care Bills of Tie-up Hospital attached with DCBO through On-line UTI Module.
- Functioning of Branch Office in DCBO
- Disbursement of Cash benefit to the IP/IW.
- The branch office under DCBO will observe same working hours as that of DCBO.
- Diarising, Scrutiny and processing of Medical reimbursement claim bills and bills of Empanelled Chemist/laboratory for payment.



Health Passbook

s a novel idea for maintaining the health records of IPs and their beneficiaries, ESIC has introduced Health Pass Book. Separate Health Passbook will be issued to each IP and his or her each d ependent member of the family. The respective ESIC Branch office / DCBO will issue the passbook to the ESI beneficiaries.

The Health Passbook is a 100 leaves small QR coded handy booklet with the credential of ESIC

beneficiary generated by the employer from the Employers' Module of Panchdeep Application and photograph affixed on its cover duly attested by the employer. It serves as a long-term permanent health record in contrast to the normal OPD slips. The QR code on the passbook will help use of Dhanwantri Mobile App for electronic documentation of health records online. All clinical findings and consultation advice of the treating Doctor will be recorded in the passbook.

IP and his or her beneficiaries need to carry the Health Passbook every time they visit the IMP/ Dispensary as it serves as a tool for identifying the credentials of the ESIC beneficiary and meant for recording clinical findings and consultation advices by the doctor.

The Health Passbook is printed in English, Hindi and vernacular languages of which the second cover gives a brief of 'ESIC - Chinta Se Mukti' Mobile App and the third cover gives a gist of the benefits under ESI Scheme. The back cover gives a visual depiction of various health tips for creating awareness and educating the ESI Scheme beneficiaries about good health practices.

Eligibility is printed on the sticker of the Passbook and in case of change of Benefit Period the beneficiary may visit ESIC website 'www.esic.nic.in to check eligibility status. Periodical renewal of the passbook also should be done by the beneficiaries.

Unified Website 'www.esic.nic.in'

The Unified Website 'www.esic.nic.in' has now become fully operational and running successfully. Before the Unified Website every Regional Offices, Sub-regional Offices, Medical Colleges and Hospitals were maintaining their separate websites, resulting which users have to visit every time on different website to gather information related to different unit of ESIC.

In 2018, Hqrs. Office has decided to launch an Unified Website for all the ESIC units viz. Regions/Sub Regions/Hospitals/Medical Colleges of ESI Corporation across India on single platform and also scrapping of various websites maintained by them.

Now, the Unified Website 'www.esic.nic.in' has become reality and 24 Regional Offices, 40 Sub Regional Offices, 154 Hospitals, 6 Medical Colleges, 1 Nursing College and 2 Dental Colleges have been migrated to Unified Website 'www.esic.nic.in', which is helpful for our stakeholders. The employer related information viz. coverage of Estb./factory, eligibility criteria for coverage of employee under the scheme, rate of contributions and other important information are also available on the website.

For migration to the Unified Website 'www.esic.nic.in', Hqrs. Office has issued Ids and passwords to field offices viz. Regional Offices/Sub Regional Offices / Hospitals / medical Colleges with a request to update information related to their Offices and jurisdictions on the pages assigned to them. Accordingly, all the field offices updated their pages and now latest and updated information are available on their pages updated by them, which is helpful for our stakeholders.

Every Office has been given their own pages for resourceful information. To make aware their Officials and stakeholders every office has been given circular tab to upload in case of any change, transfer/posting and any other information need to be publicised in public domain for the purpose of awareness.

Website also maintains contact addresses and telephone numbers of Branch Offices, Dispensaries and DCBOs which are important and resourceful for our stakeholders and now respective regions may update latest addresses and telephone numbers in case of opening of new office(s) or change of address of office to facilitate IP/IW or other stakeholders.

All the Regional Offices, Sub Regional Offices, Medical Colleges and Hospitals have been assigned the job for maintenance of respective pages on the website with the latest information and also developments, if any pertains to their region.

An idea to provide a single platform to 110 Offices of ESI Corporation across India has become virtual after launching of Unified Website 'www.esic.nic.in'.

Region in Focus - Telangana

The State of Telangana, the 29th State of the Indian Union was born on June 2, 2014. Lovingly called 'South of North and North of South', Telangana State has long been a meeting point of diverse languages and cultures. The economy of Telangana was long dominated by agriculture and in the recent past by services sector – including IT/ITES. Manufacturing, Medical Tourism,

Utilities and Construction sectors too have become significant contributors to the economy of Telangana.

Implementation of ESI Scheme in Telangaa

The ESI Scheme was implemented in the State of Telangana vide Notification No.S.O.938 dated 23.4.1955 w.e.f. 01.05.1955 under Section 1(3) read with Section 2 (12) of ESI Act 1948. The Scheme was first implemented in Twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad and thereafter extended to other geographical areas over the years in the State. Establishments too were brought under the purview of the ESI Act under Section 1(5) w.e.f. 30.03.1975.

Until recently implementation was done only in places of industrial/commercial concentration and there were 131 such centres under the State. Now under ESIC 2.0 reforms the scheme is implemented in entire 31 districts of Telangana

ESIC Regional Office, Telangana

The Regional Office is headed by Additional Commissioner & Regional Director. He is assisted by State Medical Officer, Deputy Directors, Assistant Directors and other functionaries. The Regional Office of the ESI Corporation, Telangana functions from a sprawling lush green campus situated in the Hyderabad City. The Scheme is administered through a network of Sixteen Branch Offices and one Dispensary cum Branch Office (DCBO). The cashless medical care is provided through a network of 70 Dispensaries, two Diagnostic Centers, four Hospitals run by the State Government, one ESIC Medical College and Hospital and one ESIC Super Speciality Hospital. Besides, there are a good number tie up Medical Care Facilities all over the state for providing treatment for such ailments for which treatment facilities do not exist in ESIS and ESIC hospitals. Regional Office provides cash benefit through its 16 Branch Offices and one DCBO. ESIC is also running one Medical College in Sanath Nagar, Hyderabad having intake capacity of 100 seats in Undergraduate (MBBS) course and 35% of the seats are reserved for wards of Insured Persons.

Important activities :

MSME outreach programme

As a part of Govt. of India's initiative to boost MSME sector and in line with the objectives of the Support and Outreach Programme, RO, Telangana conducted an awareness programme on ESI Scheme at Karimnagar on 05-01-2019.

Out of five key aspects for facilitating the MSME sector as envisaged by the Govt. of India, special emphasis was given to the 'sense of security for employees', and its realisation through benefits provided by the ESI Corporation. Awareness was spread among the visitors regarding the need for social security and provision of benefits to the working class, particularly the range and scale of services provided by the Corporation.

ESIC Day Fortnight celebrations - Activities from 14-02-19 to 28-02-19

As a part of celebration of ESIC Day Fortnight, in order to promote popularity and acceptability of ESI Scheme, activities like fast-track clearing of claims, organizing medical camps and conducting of seminars/workshops for employers & employees were taken up. A special cleanliness drive was also organized at the level of Regional Office. In order to showcase efficacy of DCBOs, activities taken up there during the special services fortnight focused mainly on ensuring availability of quick and prompt medical care and cash benefit at one location. Feedback was collected to improve services of the Corporation. IPs/Employers were invited to Suvidha Samagams conducted during the fortnight at Branch Offices / Regional



Office for further discussions on the issues so raised during the Awareness programmes.

During the Suvidha Samagams, efforts were made to categorise grievances raised by the stakeholders for speedy resolution at Regional Office level wherever possible. Special care was taken to encourage IPs, Employers and Employees' Representatives to attend Suvidha Samagams and raise their concerns. The Suvidha Samagams conducted during the fortnight were used to educate IPs/Employers about the nuances of the Scheme and efforts were made to address grievances on the spot.

Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan Dhan Yojana (PM-SYM)

PM-SYM is a Pension Scheme for unorganized sector workers rolled out on 15.02.2019 across the country. Regional Office, Telangana using its network of Branch



Offices had successfully coordinated with the facilitation desks set up in this regard and contributed to huge success of the Scheme in three areas which were assigned to ESIC in the State.

Atal Bimit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana (ABVKY)

All the Branch Offices took active part in propagation of Atal Bimit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana by following a target based contact programme thereby ensuring maximum reach of the Scheme.

Launch of mIMP pilot project in Telangana

A pilot mIMP project was launched in 'Tandur' Area of Telangana where an IMP was appointed (on nomination basis) under the newly launched mIMP programme. Till the end of April, 2019 a total of 937 Health Passbooks were distributed to IPs and their dependants. In order to educate the employers on generation of stickers etc for preparing Health Pass Books and availing treatment under mIMP Scheme, training programmes were conducted at employers' location. In these camps employers' representatives, trade union representatives, mIMP, mPharmacist and mDC participated to explore various aspects related to mIMP Scheme. Even though it was a pilot project, a good number of IPs and their dependents have benefitted from the HPB Scheme in conjunction with the mIMP programme. Based on the success in Tandur, Regional Office, Telangana is envisaging rolling out the programme to other remote locations during the next phase.

Years of Health Services and Social Security

Swachhata Pakhwada from 01/05/2019 to 15/05/2019:

The Regional office and it's Branch Offices observed Swachhata Pakhwada during 01/05/2019 to 15/02/2015 in which all employees took part in all the programmes. They all took part in plantation drive organised in the RO premises. Today it is a complete green premises-greenery to be seen to be believed. Regional office also has participated in 5th Garden festival conducted by Department of Horticulture, Government of Telangana and won 3rd prize for maintenance of its garden at RO campus. The lush green premises of RO Telangana drew high appreciation from the Secretary, MOLE, Government of India during one of his visits to Regional office.

The ESIC Team Telangana is working hard to live up to the expectation of the beneficiaries of the ESI Scheme in the state and also to realize the spirit of ESIC's slogan "IP is our VIP"

HOSPITAL IN FOCUS

ESIC Super Speciality Hospital, Sanathnagar, Hyderabad



Dr. Balraj Bhandar Medical Superintendent The ESIC Super Speciality Hospital with 100 bed capacity was inaugurated on 30th April, 2011. The Out Patient Department and In Patient Department in the Hospital started functioning in June, 2011 and September, 2011 respectively. The six super speciality facilities functioning in the hospital are Cardiology, Neurology, Neuro-Surgery, Paediatric Surgery,

Nephrology and Urology / Uro-Surgery.

The ISO 9001: 2015 certified Hospital caters to the super speciality treatment of patients from two states Telangana and Andhra Pradesh and has implemented most of the ESIC 2.0 reforms. The hospital has in-house 24x7 Laboratory and Radiology services. Besides outsourced housekeeping, security and maintenance department, the hospital has implemented Aadhaar based attendance system which is strictly followed.

Recent achievement of the Hospital

The In-House Hemodialysis Center was inaugurated at the hospital on 17th April, 2019. This is unique that this is for the first time in India in ESIC to initiate its own In-house hemodialysis programe, and not on PPP model as was done before in 2014 when the Hospital started hemodialysis program under PPP with 32 machines and 180-200 patients underwent hemodialysis and other patient were referred to the nearby corporate and government hospitals. Currently the hospital has a total of average 475 patients on hemodialysis program.

As the PPP model didn't yield expected results, ESIC SSH started its own hemodialysis program. The dream has come true and in-house hemodialysis unit was Inagurated on 17th April, 2019 by Prof. K. Manohar, Director, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences and Prof. Dr. Sree Bhushan

Raju and Prof. Gangadhar, Department of Nephrology – Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad. The hospital started the program by recruiting 18 patients for Maintenance Hemodialysis on three machines in three sessions per day. 10 - 12 Inpatients and Emergency cases are being Dialysed per day.

Kidney failure has become a major health problem especially in the setting of emergency endemic nephropathies and Diabetes pandemic in India. The premature Kidney disease is estimated to be 180-200 per million populations. With 16 lacs ESIC beneficiaries in the state, the number of patients with Kidney disease and those requiring Renal replacement therapy – MHD/CAPD/ transplantation is huge.

With successful initiation of In-house hemodialysis unit as a pilot project, the hospital plans to procure another 40 machines and this shall curtail the economic burden. Patients not only from Andhra Pradesh and Telangana but also from other parts of the country can also avail the opportunity.

The department of nephrology is established with three nephrologists, Dr. Susmitha, Dr. Vamsi Krishna and Dr. Deepthi working as full time Specialists. Four post general medicine senior residents Dr. Ramesh, Dr. Snigdha, Dr. Naresh and Dr. Ujjwal are also working in the department. The hospital has 5 bedded Nephrology ICU to tackle any kind of emergencies. 20 per month renal biopsies and 50 per month dialysis cannulation are being done in the department of nephrology.

The hospital has also started CAPD program and has been running successfully and also plans to start transplantation program in our center.

HOSPITAL IN FOCUS ESIC Hospital, Adityapur, Jharkhand

Spread in a sprawling area of 10 acres, the Hospital is situated in Adityapur, Saraikela – Kharsawan district of Jharkhand. Adityapur, named after Raja Aditya Pratap Singh Deo, the last ruler of Saraikela, is one of the largest industrial areas in India. The Adityapur Industrial Estate (33,970 acres, 53 sq.mile) has been Asia's largest industrial hub for a while. About 1,000 industries are

located here and about 250 are under construction. There are about 20 large scale industries such as TGS, Usha Martin, Omni Auto L.M.T and RSB. Adityapur is part of Jamshedpur Metropolitan Area and the famous Tata Steel Plant is situated in Jamshedpur.

The 50 bedded ESIC Hospital, Adityapur was acquired by ESIC from Government of Jharkhand on 02.02.2009. The construction of new 100 bedded hospital building is nearing completion in the hospital complex.

The hospital caters to the medical needs of 10 lakh ESIC beneficiaries (around 2 lakh IPs and their dependants). The hospital provides treatment facilities in General Medicine, Pulmonary Medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics, Obstretrics & Gynaecology, Orthopadeics, Opthalmology, Dental and Ayurveda.

The hospital also provides facilities for round the clock emergency care with 6 beds, physiotherapy and pharmacy. Separate Pathology, ECG and X-ray services are available in the hospital besides an immunization room for conducting vaccination programme. A 15 bedded Dialysis unit on PPP model with M/s. Nephro Plus has been established in the hospital premises.

For Secondary and Super Speciality services, the hospital has tie-up arrangements with M/s. Brahmananda Narayana Super Speciality Hospital, M/s. KGMH Medica Hospital, M/s. Meditrina Hospital, M/s. Purnima Netralaya and M/s. 111 Save Life Hospital.

The hospital maintains a clean and hygienic environment. Clean drinking water, stretchers, wheel chairs, round the clock ambulance and May I help you desk are the other facilities available in the hospital for the IPs and patients. Sufficient seating arrangements are made in the reception area and an LED TV is also provided in the reception.

On an average, around 700-800 patients avail OPD services and the bed occupancy is 90%. Hygienic meals as prescribed by the treating doctors are provided to the admitted patients and the meal is provided in separate covered thalis.

The hospital regularly organizes health check-up camps and health education camps in various industrial premises. A state run DOT centre run by the State Government is also functioning at the hospital.

The hospital is striving hard to cater to the needs and fulfill the requirement of the Insured Persons and their beneficiaries by providing quality medical services.

आकस्मिकताएँ – जरूरतें : सामाजिक सुरक्षा के परिप्रेक्ष्य में

विशिष्ट शब्द : सामाजिक सुरक्षा, आकस्मिकताएँ, आय—हानि, बीमारी, वृद्धावस्था, मृत्यु, बेराजगारी, दुर्घटना । परिचय : भगवान बुद्ध ने ज्ञान—प्राप्ति की राह में अपना राजसी घर—बार छोड़ दिया था। घर छोड़ने से पहले जीवन के कुछ विशेष एवं अवश्यंभावी तथ्यों से उनका सामना हुआ था, उन्होंने जीवन के तीन कष्ट राजमहल के बाहर देखे थे। वो थे — बीमारी, वृद्धावस्था तथा मृत्यु। जिसके बारे

में उन्होंने बाद में कहा, जीवन में दुःख हैं, दुःख का कारण है, और कारण का निवारण है।

सामाजिक सुरक्षा के परिप्रेक्ष्य में इन अवश्यंभावी तथ्यों को या (दूसरे शब्दों में कहें तो) आकस्मिकताओं को समझने की जरूरत हैं । इसी तरह से जीवन—काल में जरूरतों को भी समझने की जरूरत है। सामाजिक सुरक्षा एक उत्तर है, जिसका प्रश्न है ये आकस्मिकताएँ, ये जरूरतें। अगर हम इन आकस्मिकताओं या जरूरतों को समस्या मानें, तो सामाजिक सुरक्षा इनका समाधान है । जोखिम, विपदा, संकट, खतरा आदि को भी इन आकस्मिकताओं और जरूरतों के साथ जोड़ा और समझा जा सकता है ।

जीवन की तीन मूल जरूरतें हैं – भोजन, वस्त्र, आवास। जब व्यक्ति एक न्यूनतम स्तर पर रोजगार प्राप्त कर लेता है, तब और जब किसी अधिकतम स्तर पर भी होता है, तब भी, उसे और कई सारे आकस्मिकताओं और जरूरतों का सामना करना पड़ता है।

मुख्य रूप से इन जरूरतों तथा आकस्मिकताओं को निम्न तरीके से चिन्हित किया जा सकता है :--

1) बीमारी 2). वृद्धावस्था 3). मृत्यु 4). दुर्घटना 5). मातृत्व 6). निःशक्तता 7). बेरोजगारी 8). आय—हानि आदि ।

इनका अगर दूसरी तरह से वर्गीकरण किया जाए, जो कहा जा सकता है कि 1). बहुत बड़ी जिन्दगी (वृद्धावस्था) हो, या 2). जिन्दगी छोटी हो (अकाल मृत्यु), या 3). मेडिकल (चिकित्सा) जरूरत हो (यानि कि बीमारी, मातृत्व, दुर्घटना, निःशक्तता आदि) अथवा 4). बेरोजगारी,

के समय संसाधनों की विशेष जरूरत पडती है ।

अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय श्रम संगठन ने सामाजिक सुरक्षा को परिभाषित करते हुए मुख्यतः निम्न आकस्मिकताओं को चिन्हित किया है :–

"बीमारी, मातृत्व, रोजगार जनित चोट, बेरोजगारी, निःशक्तता, वुद्धावस्था तथा मृत्यु के वजह से आय की हानि,"...

'सामाजिक सुरक्षा' पर अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय श्रम संगठन के मानक विभिन्न आर्थिक प्रणालियों और विकास के चरणों के तहत विभिन्न प्रकार की सामाजिक सुरक्षा कवरेज के नाम करते हैं । सामाजिक सुरक्षा संवहन (कन्वेंशन) कई प्रकार के विकल्प और लचीले खंड (clauses) प्रदान करते हैं, जो सार्वभौमिक कवरेज के लक्ष्य को धीरे–धीरे पूरा करने की अनुमति देते हैं। वैश्वीकरण की दुनिया में, जहां लोग वैश्विक आर्थिक जोखिमों के सम्पर्क में हैं, इस तथ्य की बढ़ती चेतना है कि एक व्यापक 'राष्ट्रीय सामाजिक सुरक्षा नीति' संकटों के कई नकारात्मक सामाजिक प्रभावों के खिलाफ एक मजबूत बफर प्रदान कर सकती है। इन कारणों से, 2012 में, अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय श्रम सम्मेलन ने एक महत्वपूर्ण नया लेखपत्र अपनाया, 'सामाजिक संरक्षण फ्लोर्स' सिफारिश (संख्या 202) {Social Protection Floors Recommendation (No. 202)

सामाजिक सुरक्षा (न्यूनतम मानक) कन्वेंशन 1952 (नंबर 102) सामाजिक सुरक्षा लाभ के स्तर और उन शर्तों के तहत न्यूनतम मानक प्रदान करता है जिसके तहत विभिन्न हितलाभ प्रदान किए जाते हैं । इसमें सामाजिक सुरक्षा की 9 प्रमुख शाखाएं शामिल हैं, जैसे चिकित्सा देखभाल, बीमारी, बेरोजगारी, बुढ़ापा, रोजगार की चोट, परिवार, मातृत्व, अमान्यता और आश्रितजन हितलाभ ।

बीमारी — शरीर अपने आप में एक complicated मशीन है । इस शरीर में कभी भी कोई दिक्कत आ सकती है। जिसे बीमारी कह सकते हैं । बीमारी के दौरान "कार्य से अनुपस्थिति" होने के कारण "आय की हानि" तो होती है । और दूसरी तरफ इस बीमारी को ठीक करने के लिए मेडिकल देखरेख की जरूरत होती है । अतः बीमारी दो तरह से वार करती है। मेडिकल जरूरतों की वजह से खर्च बढ़ता है और दूसरी तरफ आय अर्जन की क्षमता का, बीमारी के दौरान, ह्रास होता है ।

वृद्धावस्था:— एक उम्र के बाद (किसी के लिए वह उम्र 60 वर्ष हो सकती है, किसी के लिए 70 वर्ष) व्यक्ति को active work life से retire होना पड़ता है। उसके बाद व्यक्ति का शरीर कमजोर पड़ने लगता है। एक तरफ वह कार्य नहीं कर सकता, तो दूसरी तरफ उसको मेडिकल देखरेख, व्यक्तिगत देखरेख आदि की जरूरतें बढ़ जाती हैं। इस स्थिति में भी आय अर्जन की कमी होती है, तथा दूसरी ओर खर्च करने के लिए संसाधनों की जरूरत होती है।

मृत्यु — किसी भी व्यक्ति की मृत्यु से कमी आती है। यह कमी emotional के अलावा आर्थिक रूप से भी आती है। अगर मृत्यु को प्राप्त होने वाला व्यक्ति परिवार का मुखिया हो, या substantially important आय अर्जित करने वाला हो तो स्थिति और मुश्किल होती है। ऐसे लोगों पर परिवार (आय नहीं अर्जित करने वाले) के अन्य सदस्य आश्रित होते हैं। अतः मृत्यु की स्थिति में भी जरूरतें जन्म लेती है। उक्त परिवार की आय में कमी आती है।

मातृत्व :--यह एक खुशी का समय होता है परिवार में। परन्तु अगर मातृत्व सुख प्राप्त करने वाली स्त्री रोजगार में नियोजित है, तब इस खुशी के समय उसके आय-अर्जन में रूकावट आती है। इसके अलावा मातृत्व के process के दौरान, उसके देखरेख की जरूरत बढ़ जाती है। इन सबके लिए संसाधनों की आवश्यकता होती है।

निःशक्तता – किसी भी चोट, दुर्घटना आदि की वजह से अच्छे, खासे व्यक्ति के शरीर में अगर कोई क्षति हो जाए, जो वह निःशक्तता कहलाता है । इसकी वजह से व्यक्ति के शारीरिक रूप से आय अर्जन की क्षमता में कमी आती है । ऐसी निःशक्तता स्थाई हो सकती है या थोड़े समय के लिए हो सकती है । विशेषकर स्थाई निःशक्तता व्यक्ति के productivity में रूकावट लाती है । अतः आवश्यकताए



बढ़ जाती हैं । यह जरूरत का समय होता है ।

बेरोजगारी — शारीरिक, सामाजिक या आर्थिक कारणों से कई रोजगारयुक्त व्यक्ति भी कुछ समय के लिए या स्थाई रूप से बेरोजगार हो सकते हैं । ऐसे समय वह व्यक्ति अपने परिवार का लालन—पालन कैसे करेगा? संसाधनों की जरूरत होती है । आवश्यकताएं मुंह बाए खड़ी होती हैं ।

सामाजिक सुरक्षा प्रशासन (यूएसए) के संबंध में, यूएसए में सामाजिक सुरक्षा अधिनियम और संबंधित कानून, ऐसे कई कार्यक्रम स्थापित करते हैं, जिनके मूल उद्देश्य हैं ऐसे व्यक्तियों और परिवारों की भौतिक जरूरतें प्रदान करना, ऐसी बीमारियां जो उनकी बचत का उपयोग कर सकती हैं, ऐसे खर्चों से वृद्ध और विकलांग लोगों की रक्षा करना, परिवारों को एक साथ रखना और बच्चों को स्वस्थ और सुरक्षित बढ़ने का मौका देना । अमेरिकी सामाजिक सुरक्षा अधिनियम और संबंधित कानूनों के तहत शामिल कार्यक्रमों को सेवानिवृत्ति बीमा; उत्तरजीविता बीमा; विकलांगता बीमा; वृद्धों, विकलांगों और अन्तिम चरण के गुर्दे की बीमारी वाले लोगों के लिए अस्पताल और चिकित्सा बीमा; प्रिस्किप्शन ड्रग बेनेफिट; मेडिकेयर प्रिस्किप्शन ड्रग कॉस्ट के साथ अतिरिक्त मदद; पूरक सुरक्षा आय; विशेष वयोवृद्ध लाभ; बेरोजगारी बीमा; और विभिन्न सार्वजनिक सहायता और कल्याणकारी सेवाएं हैं । जरूरतमंद परिवारों के लिए अस्थायी सहायता सहित; चिकित्सा सहायता, मातृ शिश स्वास्थ्य सेवाएं; बाल सहायता प्रवर्तन; परिवार और बाल कल्याण सेवाएं; खाद्य टिकट और ऊर्जा सहायता (सन्दर्भ – https://www.ssa.gov / OPHome / handbook. 01 / handbook-0100.html)

श्रम संहिता, भारत के श्रम और रोजगार मंत्रालय की सामाजिक सुरक्षा, 2018 पर (ड्राफ्ट वर्जन 2.0, मार्च 2018) यह भी जोर देती है कि यह सामान्य रूप से समाज का कर्तव्य है और विशेष रूप से सरकार यह सुनिश्चित करे कि जिसने अपने अच्छे दिनों में राष्ट्र के विकास में कोई योगदान नहीं दिया है उसे अपने दुर्बल दिनों में बीमारी, दुर्घटना, बेरोजगारी, विकलांगता, मातृत्व और बुढ़ापे जैसी समस्याओं का सामना करने के लिए अकेला छोड़ दिया जाए। एक सामाजिक सुरक्षा प्रणाली के तहत, इन जोखिमों और घटनाओं को एक मजबूत सामाजिक सुरक्षा ढ़ाचे के माध्यम से छोटे योगदान के माध्यम से प्रबंधित किया जा सकता है । संदर्भ – (Labour code on social security 2018, {Page-5, about social security)https://

ESIC compensates the victims of Fire Tragedy and Rewards the Saviour

Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Labour & Employment announced compensation of ₹10 lakh each to the families of those who lost their lives, ₹2 lakh each for those who sustained serious injuries and ₹1 lakh each for those who suffered minor injuries in the fire accident that occurred on 17.12.2018 at ESIC Hospital Andheri, Mumbai. A total of 13 persons lost their lives and 27 persons were seriously injured and another 103 sustained minor injuries in the tragic incident. The injured persons were immediately shifted to nearby hospitals and provided necessary treatment.

Immediately after the fire incident, the Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Labour & Employment held a meeting with officials of Labour Ministry and ESIC Hqrs. at Delhi and directed to extend all the possible help to the kins of deceased and injured persons. A team of doctors from ESIC Delhi rushed to Mumbai for giving necessary assistance to the victims. The Hon'ble Minister along with Secretary, Ministry of Labour & Employment and Director General, ESIC visited the hospital to oversee the relief work and to meet the injured persons and kins of deceased.

During the fire incident, Mr. Siddrameshwar Siddharam Humanabade, Food Delivery Boy of Swiggy acted as a saviour and helped the fire victims and saved the lives of 10 persons beyond the call of his duty. In recognition of his selfless service, Mr. Siddrameshwar Siddharam Humanabade was rewarded with a cheque of ₹1 lakh by Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar, Hon'ble Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Labour and Employment, Govt. of India at a special function held on 1st January, 2019 at New Delhi.

Speaking on the occasion Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar said that "It is also praiseworthy to mention that Mr. Siddrameshwar continued his selfless service for rescuing the victims until he started feeling uncomfortable due to inhaling of toxic gases due to the fire.
